Please choose **at least** 5 tasks to complete over the half term – **at least one per row**.



I enjoy reading, writing and speaking.	Practise writing your home address. Don't forget to use capital letters to begin each word.	Read a favourite animal story book (e.g. The Gruffalo).	Write 3 facts about your favourite animal to make a simple fact file.
I enjoy working with numbers and being scientific.	Practise writing the numbers one to ten (digits and words).	Can you find /draw a mammal? What makes mammals special?	As you are walking or in the car, look for numbers between 1 and 10. What different places can you see them in?
I enjoy painting, drawing and visualising.	Draw/paint a picture of your favourite animal.	Make your own animal mask.	Find lots of pictures of different animals and make a collage.
I enjoy being active and doing hands-on activities.	Perhaps you could build a hedgehog house or bug hotel in your garden or leave food out for the birds (or those hedgehogs!)	Explore your garden or go on an autumn walk and collect as many different types of autumn leaves as you can. Make some leaf rubbings, or a picture with them.	Draw a map of your route to school. What landmarks do you pass on the way? Draw these on your map and label them.
I enjoy making and listening to music and poetry.	Sing songs or nursery rhymes about animals. For example: Who built the Ark? Old MacDonald Had a Farm.	Sit in your garden or go on a walk, what different animals can you hear?	Make your own silly song about an animal.
