How many pencils are there altogether?

559 pencils	
167 pencils	392 pencils

- 2** Jay has 263 stickers. Lilah has 189 stickers.
How many more stickers does Jay have than Lilah?

263 stickers	
189 stickers	74 stickers

- 3** Dad drives 208 miles from London to Manchester and then 213 miles to Glasgow.
How far did he travel altogether?

421 miles	
208 miles	213 miles

- 4** Lucy wants to raise £1000 for charity. She has raised £697. How much more does she need to raise to reach her target?

£1000	
£697	£303

- 5** Finn had 536 house points but increased this number by 178. What is Finn's house point total now?

714 house points	
536 house points	178 house points
