Your challenge over the half term is to create your own Roman Project to show what you've learnt and to explore your favourite parts of Roman life! You can choose any project idea from the list below or come up with one of your own! Be as creative and imaginative as you can

## ■ Design & Create

- Build a **model of a Roman town** showing features like roads, baths, and villas.
- Make your own **Roman tunic or piece of clothing** – use an old sheet, fabric, or even paper!
- Create a **model of Hadrian's Wall** using cardboard, bricks, Lego, or anything you can find!
- Design and decorate your own **Roman shield or helmet**.

## —■ Write & Research

- Write a **short diary entry** from the point of view of a Roman soldier on Hadrian's Wall.
- Create a **fact file or poster** about a famous Roman leader such as **Julius Caesar** or **Emperor Hadrian**.
- Write a **non-fiction report** about **why the Romans invaded Britain**.
- Make a **mini Roman newspaper**, with articles about daily life in Roman Britain!

## ■ Invent & Imagine

- Write a **Roman myth** or story set in Ancient Rome.
- Make a **Roman board game** that teaches people about Roman life.
- Create a **timeline** showing the key events in the Roman Empire.
