

## Adverbs

An **adverb** is used to describe a verb.

Example: The child spoke **softly**. Here the word 'spoke' is the **verb**, and **softly** is the **adverb** because it describes how the boy speaks.

**Adverbs** tell us many things about the **verb**:

- How something happens: **quickly, slowly**
- Where or when it happens: **today, yesterday**
- How often it happens: **daily, frequently**
