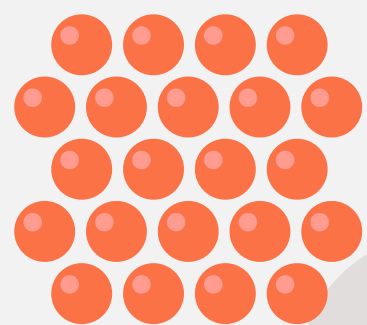


SPRING PROJECT

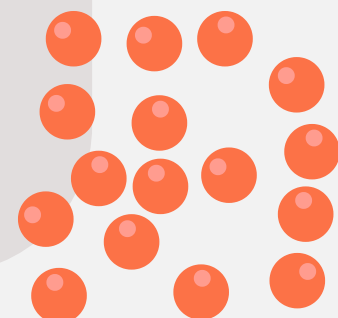
Due in Wednesday 25th February 2026
