Year 6	Lucy	For her incredible descriptive writing.

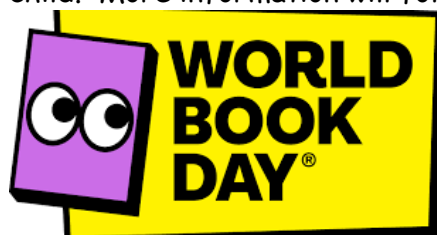
Eco Work
