## Playground Development

I am pleased to inform you that part of the playground will be refurbished at the start of the summer term. The proposed design will see the shed moved, a painted sports surface and junior games ends, an open gazebo/seating area, outdoor library and quiet area. This project is mainly being funded by a generous donation received by a past governor, with additional amounts from a designated amount from the school budget and a donation of $£ 5000$ from the PTA. This is the first phase of a project to improve the whole playground. In the second phase we are hoping to put in an activity centre and a new outdoor area for Reception Class, however this will cost the same amount again and further funding needs to be sought.
During the time of the works, there may need to be some adjustments to arrangements for dropping off and collecting but this will be communicated nearer the time.
