Spotlight on ... Plastic

- **REUSE** – Refill plastic water bottles and containers, use plastic jars or tubs for storing food, stationery, or small items. You could even turn plastic bottles into plant pots or bird feeders.
- **RECYCLE** – Always clean plastic containers before recycling to remove food or liquid and then place recyclable plastics in recycling bins.
- **REDUCE** – Buy products with less plastic packaging. When you are at the supermarket you could buy fruit and vegetables that are sold loosely rather than in a plastic bag.
