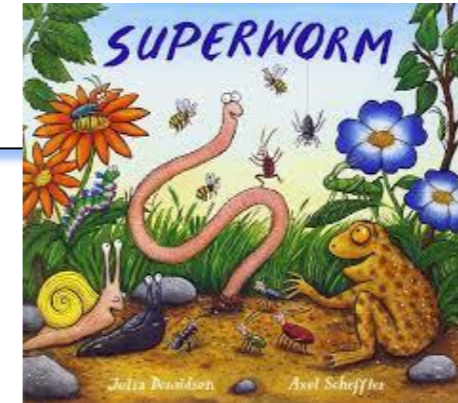


Our book focus this week is:

Superworm

This week in Reception Class...

In maths this week the children have started a new block called Visualise, Build and Map. We started the week by recapping odd and even numbers and then recognized and created our own repeated patterns. The children have enjoyed finding patterns in their environment.

We have been making habitat pictures for minibeasts. The children have been deciding best places for a selection of minibeasts to live such as butterflies on the flowers. We have been using our Forest School experiences to think about where we have found bugs. The children enjoy looking under the logs around the fire pit to find worms and woodlice. The children told us that they live there as it is dark and damp.

This week we had an assembly by The Energy Monster Squad. They have been encouraging us to do our bit to care for the planet. We will be collecting team points for remembering to turn off lights and taps we do not need on.

The children have enjoyed joining in with repeated lines from within the story. They have also been adding actions to key parts such as super long and super strong. We made actions for all Superworm's jobs.

Each group have been describing a chosen minibeast. The children have been writing a description of each insect and enjoyed finding out some interesting facts too! We have been listening to the descriptions and then guessing the name of the insect.

During COOL Time, the children made wanted posters for their favourite minibeast.

On Thursday we took part in our first Sports Day! Our teachers are very proud of the way we listened to instructions and tried our hardest in all of the events we took part in. We did a running race, throwing the beanbag, egg and spoon and an obstacle race before ending with a house team relay with Years 1 and 2. We had great fun!

This week the children have enjoyed cutting and sticking 2D shapes into their favourite minibeasts. The children have followed a pattern or made their own designs. They have also used playdoh to design a superhero costume for Superworm. We also enjoyed singing the Wiggly Woo song.
