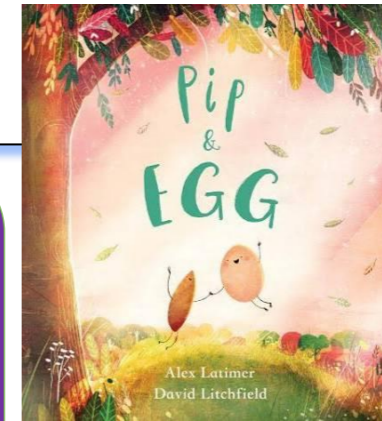

# This week in Reception Class...

Instead of afternoon play this week, we have enjoyed listening to stories in the shade. This has been a great opportunity to develop the children's comprehension skills. They are also asking some super questions to develop their understanding.

This week in maths the children have continued their learning around shape, position and direction. They have enjoyed working in groups to make creations using different materials. They have also been describing scenes and how images change when we look at them from different positions.

As we have read our focus story this week, the children have taken a real interest in the pictures within the story. We have enjoyed talking about features such as glaciers and referring to previous knowledge of growing and changing. The children have also enjoyed discussing the friendship of the characters and how this has continued for many years.

In guided writing this week the children have been recording simple sentences using a picture. The children have been completing the sentence I can see...

Due to the red alert for weather this week we have not done PE and have tried to stay as cool as possible!

The children have enjoyed making scenes from the story this week and making models linked to maths. They have also been making some lovely pictures using leaf rubbings.

This week we have talked a lot about sun safety during this very hot spell. The children have been very good at remembering to wear their sunhats and drink plenty of water. They have also been remembering to take so time during lunchtime to rest in the shade.

The adults have seen a great improvement in the children's letter formation and using resources around the classroom to support their independent writing.

We have also been looking at optical illusion pictures and describing what we see. The children have been learning to listen to, and respect others' ideas and perspective.
