I enjoy reading, writing and speaking.	Plan a visit to the library and to find some books about the seasons. Take a photo or draw a picture of you reading.	Choose your favourite season and write 3 sentences to explain why you have chosen it.	Practise talking in sentences to an adult at home about the seasons.
I enjoy working with numbers and being scientific.	Can you write the names of all 4 seasons? You could even draw a little picture to match each one.	Write the name of the season in which you celebrate your birthday.	How many days are in a week? Can you write the name of each day?
I enjoy painting, drawing and visualising.	Paint, draw or create a collage of your favourite season.	Make a 3D model of a tree showing leaves from your favourite season.	Collect some leaves and create some leaf rubbings.
I enjoy being active and doing hands-on activities.	Dress up in some clothes to match a season from the year. Take a picture and I will try to guess the season.	Make a crown of fallen leaves.	Go for a walk and look at the trees, can you see them changing?
I enjoy making and listening to music and poetry.	Write your own seasons poem. Practise saying your poem out aloud to an audience.	Listen to some different styles of music, what seasons does the music remind you of?	Use musical instruments to create sounds from the different seasons.
