

This week, the children who access Times Table Rockstars have been taking part in an online tournament with other children across the country. The children who have taken part, have been using their times table knowledge to score as many points as they can for their classes and by the end of the week Class 6 were placed 213 out of a whopping 28,385 classes (top 1%) and the school placed 219 out of 3,891 schools in total throughout the country.
